

## REACH DECLARATION

The company HBIS GROUP Serbia Iron & Steel d.o.o. Beograd hereby confirms that it is aware of its obligations ensuing from the Regulation No. 1907/2006 of the European Parliament and Council concerning the Registration, Evaluation, Authorization and Restriction of Chemicals („REACH”) and is in compliance with them.

Our company confirms that our articles do not contain any substance in quantity totaling over one tonne per year, which is intended to be released under normal or reasonably foreseeable conditions of use, and thus no registration obligation for substances in articles according to article 7 of REACH applies.

On January 21<sup>st</sup>, 2025 ECHA has included further substances identified as SVHCs (Substances of Very High Concern) in the "Candidate List" please see <https://echa.europa.eu/web/guest/candidate-list-table>

The substances identified as SVHCs contained in the Candidate List issued on 21<sup>st</sup> January, 2025 have been reviewed by HBIS GROUP Serbia Iron & Steel d.o.o. Beograd and pursuant to Article 33 REACH we confirm that to our best knowledge articles supplied to your company do not contain any of these substances at concentrations above 0.1 % (w/w). In a case that our article contains SVHC above set concentrations, we will inform our customer without delay.


